If a particular product, (for example: peaches, plums, pears, cheese) is not available in Algoma then, with permission, it may be sourced from Northern Ontario or from Ontario. All food vendors are required to be familiar with Algoma Public Health's "Operating Guidelines for Farmers' Markets".

All vendors are expected to complete an Algoma Public Health's Farmers' Market Food Vendor application form (even if not selling food items) along with a Johnson Farmers' Market Vendor application form.

Fees are for the cost of the table, location and joint advertising.

Saturday fees: One table fee – June 5 to October 19, 2021 - \$285 (19-weeks) *Payable by May 1, 2021*

Please speak with manager if needing more than 1 space.

Associate fee is \$60 for the season.

Yearly membership fee of \$5.00 entitles the vendor to organizational membership with full rights and responsibilities.
